Regular Meeting  
January 11, 2018

Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:08pm.

Dave Ras made the motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting seconded by Larry Thompson, with exception of changing the dates of the Supervisor training. Carried.

Highway Report: The crew has helped Village with a water leak near the highway building. New tires on the Mac. They have done 23 trips plowing. New loader, and roller to be here next week. Heard from Cash Davison that the Narrows Bridge is set for a re-do next year (2019). Letter from State on shared services. The Supervisor will call on that.

Highway & General Fund Bills: Highway abstract #1 containing vouchers #1-12 totaling \$6428.74 & General Fund Vouchers abstract #1 containing vouchers #1-4 totaling \$4,913.93 were approved for payment on a motion made by Dianne Freiner and seconded by David Ras. Carried.

Dog Control: Contract with the Hornell Humane Society was discussed. It was generally agreed to turn it down for now.

Historian: Slow time for Historian at this point, only one inquiry. Historian would like a historical sign for the jail.

Clerk Report: Revenue for the month of December was \$65.00 with the Supervisor receiving \$28.33.

New Business: Scott Odell & Bill Crubaugh gave the yearend report for the Ambulance & Fire Departments. It was a thorough report of all fire & ambulance calls plus the man hours used.
